
## **Safety Warnning and Considerations**

- Clean only with a dry cloth or other similar materials.
- · Install your product in a dry location that does not interfere with your vehicle's equipment.
- Do not block any ventilation openings when installing this product.
- Do not mount in the engine conpartment of your vehicle or any hot surfaces.


- Fused shall be replaced only with the correct type and fuse value, and only when the apparatus is powered off.




**Note:** To watch video the parking wire should be connected the brake signal.

Connecting the reverse signal at taillight on the car (12V+ Required for Signal).





After connecting, when you start up the reverse gear, the unit will receive the picture from car rear view camera.


## **Speaker Connection**

- We recommended using car speaker with minimum 40 Watt potential.
- Headunits potential power may result in damaging your OE speakers at higher volumes.
- Use  $4\Omega$  -8 $\Omega$  (Ohm impedance) speakers only; using higher or lesser impedance may damage the headunit.
- Speaker cables and / or optional external power amplifiers must always be about 30cm away from the antenna and / or antenna extension parts.
- Do not connect the speaker leads of the power harness to battery; otherwise, the unit will be seriously damaged.
- Before connecting the speaker leads the harness to the speakers, check the speaker wiring in your car.

Connect the speakers according the following diagram, incorrect connections will damage the headunit or your vehicle's speakers.








